CRIMINAL ORDINANCE

CHAPTER G--INCHOATE CRIMES

ARTICLE 700: ATTEMPT

1 (A) <u>Attempt</u>: No person shall engage in conduct within the Tribal jurisdiction which shall substantially assist or contribute to the commission of any offense under Tribal, Federal, or State laws applicable to the jurisdiction in which any part of the offense was to be completed with the kind of intent necessary for the commission of the crime.

(B) <u>Punishment</u>: Any person found guilty of attempt shall be imposed a fine as if that crime had been completed.

ARTICLE 701 2: CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY

1 (A) <u>CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY</u>: No person shall intentionally engage with one (1) or more persons to agree to perform a criminal act or to cause the performance of a crime that is in violation of Tribal, Federal, or State laws applicable to the jurisdiction in which the conduct was agreed to have been performed, and any one person commits an overt act with the objective of the conspiracy.

(B) <u>Punishment</u>: Any person found guilty of criminal conspiracy shall be imposed a fine as if that crime had been completed.

ARTICLE 702: SOLICITATION

1 (A) <u>Solicitation</u>: No person shall intentionally recruit, incite, entice, offer, advise, encourage, or order any another person to commit a criminal act, knowing that such an act is punishable under the laws of another jurisdiction or Tribal jurisdiction.

(B) Under this Ordinance a person who solicits another with the intent that such person commit an criminal offense, which that person otherwise would have not performed or considered, had it not been for that person offering encouragement, advise, or offering consideration or something of value shall be guilty of solicitation.

(B) <u>Punishment</u>: A person found guilty of solicitation shall be imposed of a fine not to exceed Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) and or no more than two (2) months jail.
